 - a. Resolved contract was not violated
 - 4.1.a.1 Tutors are getting a 2% raise because minimums go up by that, those that are here from previous year get a 3% raise, because of negotiated salary rate increase
 - 4.1.a.1.1 Suzanne H asked if there are other areas on campus where it does not work that way
 - 4.1.a.2 The negotiated salary increase applies to all part-time titles listed in Article 28.
 - 4.1.a.3 Similar issue to what we had with the part time counselors rate that did not previously exist.
 - 4.1.a.3.1 One option is to put every part time title in Article 28 in the contract (same % increases)
 - b. Staff Associates
 - 4.1.b.1 Growing Number of Staff Associates 4 more will be hired
 - 4.1.b.2 During negotiations the college refers to our lean administration and low cost expenditures in SUNY.
 - 4.1.b.3 Most SAs do administrative work
 - 4.1.b.4 New ad for SA says administrative and supervisor experience required.

 - b. Adjuncts are getting paid correctly, but they're not hired as adjunct faculty with the option of joining the FA and are not paying dues.
 - c. Jeanette & Peggy will follow up with Brenda Dawe
- 5.2 Promotion & Appointment Packets are due in March, which means there was only a week before they have to go to the Dean
 - a. Rhoda is in charge of calendar
 - b. Reminder that calendar dates are guidelines to keep the process moving and on track.
